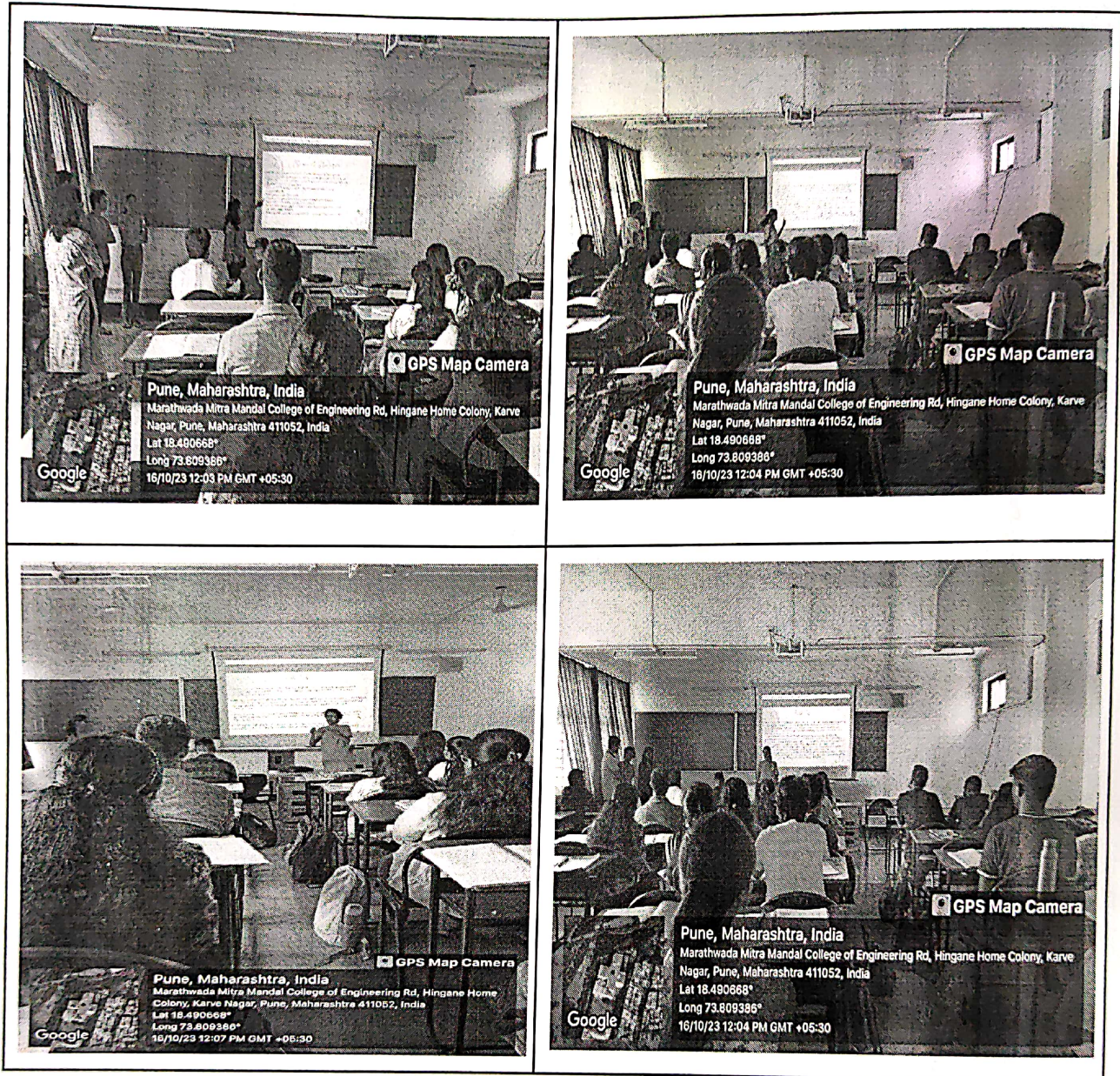
Outcomes of the Session:
