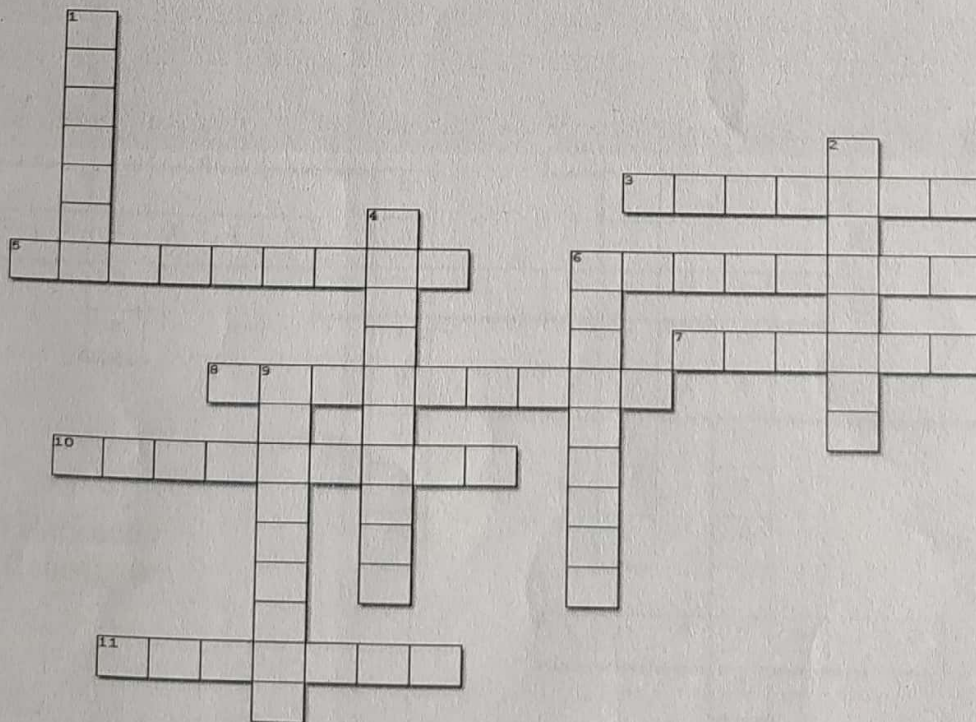
Outcome of the Session:

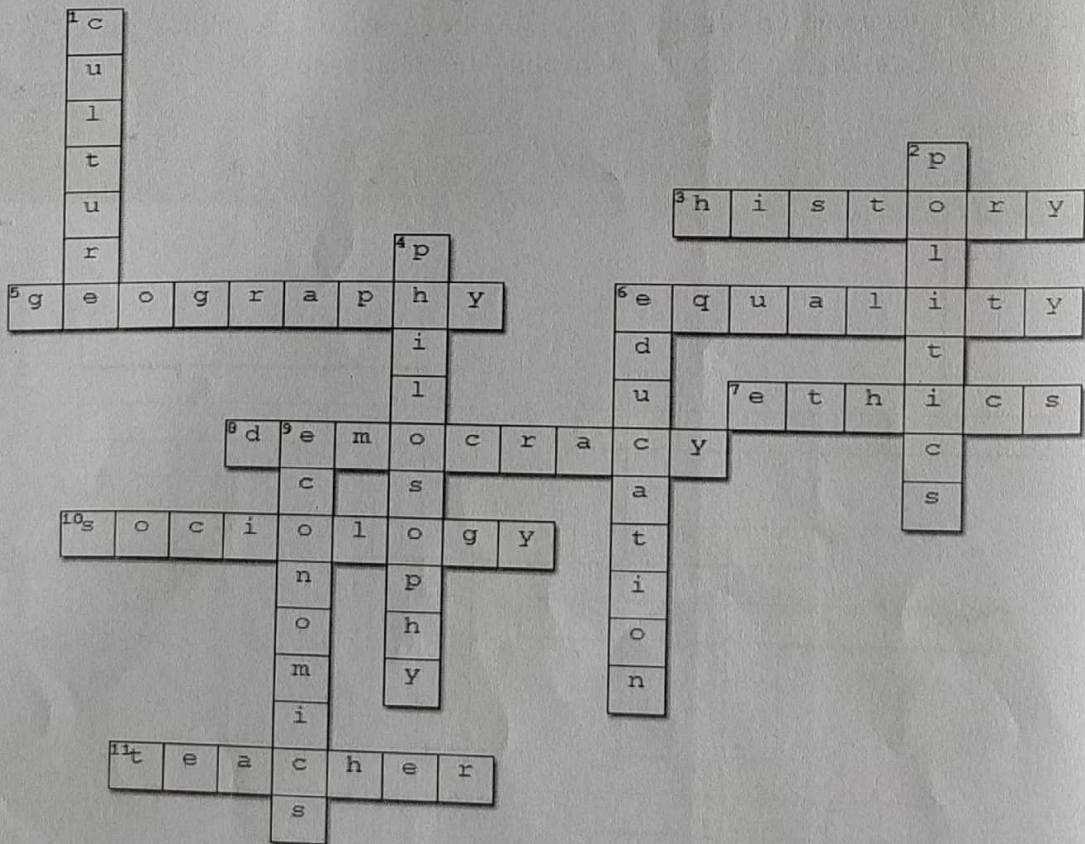

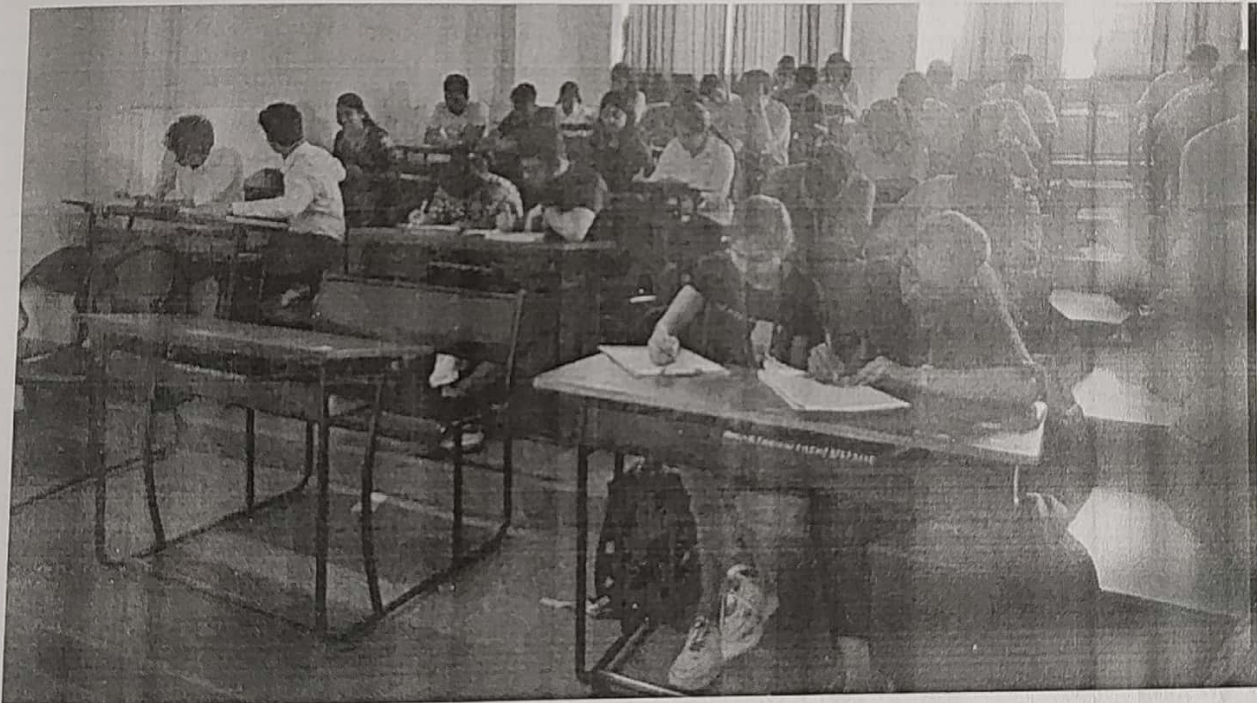
