BETA believes in Unity is Strength and looking forward to organizing amazing events with the help of SE coordinators.

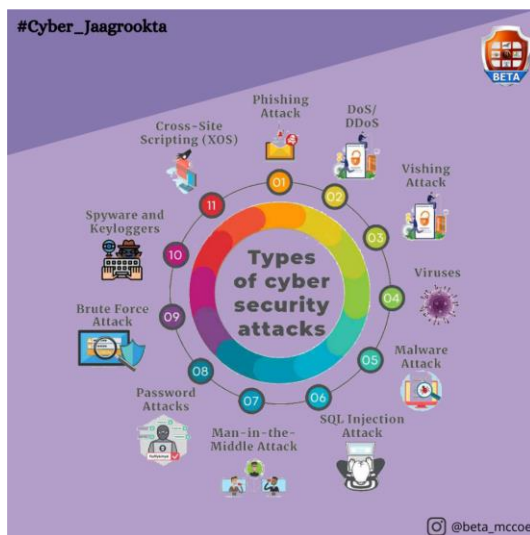
Event Name- CyberJagrooktaDiwas

Be mindful of every post you create. Do not publish content you wouldn't want family, friends and potential employers to see.

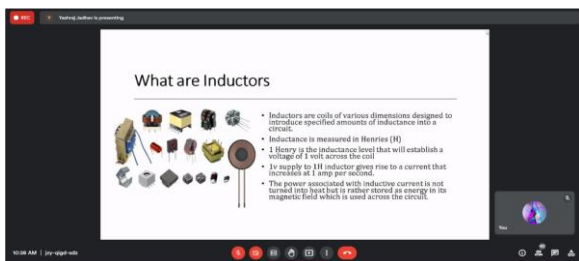
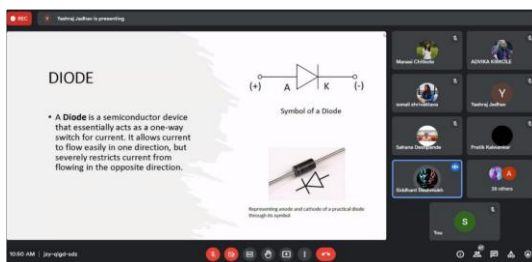
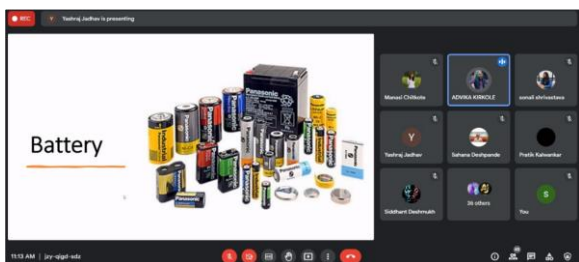
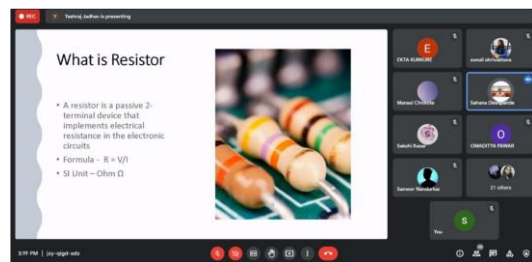
