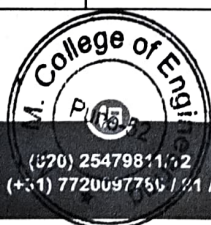

**Item No1: Confirmation of MoM of last meeting**

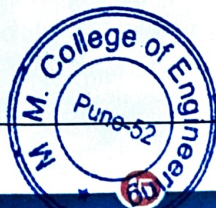

**Item No 2: To consider changes in Academic Council Member List**

**Item No. 03: To Consider the recommendation by Dean Academics**

- The Academic Council approved the tentative academic planner for AY 2026-27.
  - The list of Open Elective subject syllabus, MDM, Honors and Double Minor basket was presented and approved by all members.
- Few suggestions related to Honor subjects are given by Mr. Deepak Patil.

Eligibility for admission to the UG Bachelor's Degree with Double Minor/Honours /Research as per UGC guidelines: Minimum CGPA/CPI of 7.5 or minimum 75% after second semester for UG Bachelor's Degree with Double Minor/ Honours and Minimum CGPA/CPI of 7.5 or minimum 75% after sixth semester for UG Bachelor's Degree with Research. Academic Council members along with Dr Sudeep Thepade , VC nominee gave his confirmation for the same.

Following points presented and approved by all members

- Updated SY structure with VEC1-Environment Sustainability, VEC2- Universal Human Values and One subject on Scientific Research and Publications was presented and approved.
- Modifications in TY structure such as credit distribution, inclusion of syllabus of Reasoning and Aptitude Development and Introduction of EDI-I & II were presented and approved.
- An initiative of Co-teaching in curriculum is discussed and approved by all members.
- The decisions of the Academic Standing Committee, including matters related to the modification of the SY Computer Engineering subject *Database Management*



Systems, CEP, the course code scheme, and co-teaching, were presented to the members for discussion. As the DUPC and DPPC are already functioning effectively, no concerns were raised by any of the Heads of Departments.

#### Item No. 04: To consider the recommendations by Examination Cell

- The cumulative result analysis of First Year and Second Year was presented by Dr. P. S. Purandare, Controller of Examinations, and was approved by the members. Dr. S. R. Sakhare suggested that the analysis of the FY Mechanical results should be conducted in a manner that identifies the subjects in which the majority of students have backlogs.
- The summary of the question paper audit was presented by Dr. P. S. Purandare, Controller of Examinations. The following suggestions were provided by the members:
  1. The difficulty level of the question paper should be aligned with the marks distribution.
  2. For First Year (FY) and Second Year (SY), questions should cover BTL Levels 1 to 4.
  3. Approximately 20-25% of the questions should be from BTL Level 4 and above.
  4. The question paper format should be finalized and approved by the Course Coordinator and BoS Chairperson.
  5. Course Outcomes (CO) and the corresponding BTL level should be indicated for each question in the question paper.
  6. BoS Chairperson should ensure that the question paper meets the required standards by verifying the appropriate distribution of marks, alignment with **Bloom's Taxonomy Levels (BTL)**, and proper mapping with the **Course Outcomes (COs)**.
- Decisions of the Academic Standing Committee, including matters related to examination and result such as Incorporation of University PRN number on mark sheet along with college PRN, Progression for dissertation (M. Tech/ MBA) with clear results of Sem I&II, Grade Card issuing frequency (hard Copy) -Yearly were presented to members for discussion and approval.
- Dr. P. S. Purandare discussed the malpractice policy. It was approved by all members that in case of any malpractice, the performance of the entire End-Term Examination (ETE) will be cancelled. However, the student will be permitted to appear for the Re-ETE examination with a prescribed penalty.

#### Item No. 05: Recommendations by the Board of Studies

##### D1. Artificial Intelligence And Data Science Engineering

1. The Head of the Artificial Intelligence and Data Science Engineering department presented the changes in SY syllabus. Mr. Deepak Patil suggested that the name of the subject "Campus to Corporate" should be changed to a more generic title.



2. The Third Year syllabus was approved with minor suggestions by Mr. Deepak Patil. He recommended including the topic "AI-Driven Development" in the subject *Software Development Methodologies and Testing*. Additionally, it was suggested that the *Natural Language Processing* syllabus should include voice-based NLP content and related technologies.

#### **D2.Computer Engineering**

1. The Head of the Computer Engineering department presented the changes in SY syllabus.
2. Approval was given for TY Computer Engineering syllabus.

#### **D3.Electrical Engineering**

1. The Head of the Electrical Engineering department presented the changes in SY syllabus.
2. Approval was given for TY Electrical Engineering syllabus.

#### **D4.Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering**

1. The Head of the Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering department presented the changes in SY syllabus.
2. Approval was given for TY E&TC Engineering syllabus. Dr. S. R. Sakhare suggested introducing **Video Analytics** as an Elective-II subject.

#### **D5.Information Technology**

1. The Head of the IT department presented the changes in SY syllabus.
2. Approval was given for TY IT syllabus.

#### **D6.Mechanical Engineering**

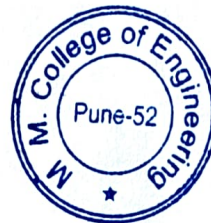
1. The Head of the Mechanical Engineering department presented the changes in SY syllabus.
