3. Discussions:

Opening Remarks

The meeting commenced with a welcome address by the Chairperson, **Dr Sawaikar**, who extended a cordial welcome to all members of the Board and invited participants. Presentation of Proposed Course Syllabus Revisions

- Performing Arts – Presentation by Dr. Dipmala Sali.
- Yoga and Meditation – Presentation by Mr. Avinash Shinde.

During their presentations, the Course Coordinators provided a comprehensive overview of the proposed syllabus revisions, Teaching-learning methodologies, Assessment and evaluation framework, outlining the rationale underpinning the changes and the academic considerations that informed the revision process.

The Board noted that the proposed revisions were designed to enhance academic rigour, improve curriculum relevance, strengthen student engagement, and facilitate the development of technical, analytical, interpersonal, and lifelong learning competencies.
